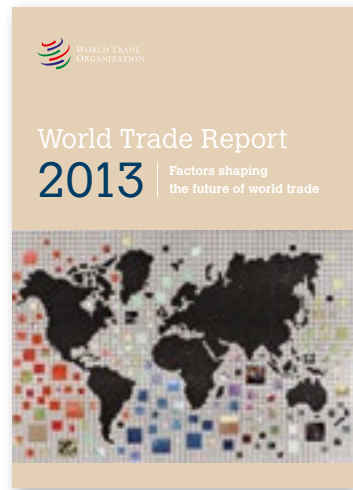

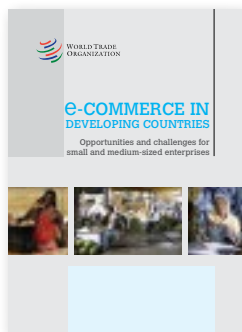


International Trade Statistics
